ENTRY AND GETTING AROUND

There are a number of entry points to the Optus Gympie Music Muster. The main entrance is accessible via Amamoor Creek Road. Day Parking will be available upon entry to the Muster site, and shuttle bus services run throughout the day and evening from the campsites and day parking to the entertainment precinct.

TICKETS AND WRISTBANDS

You will have received a ticket with barcode upon purchase. If you selected an e-ticket option, make sure the name on your ticket matches the name on your ID. If you have purchased a Muster Mates, Muster Family or Muster Musketeers ticket, you will have one ticket that enables entry for two or four people.

Each person on a Muster Mates, Muster Family or Muster Musketeers ticket will be fitted with an individual wristband, but must arrive together with their ticket at the ticketing booth.

Take good care of your wristband. It is not transferable and once it is removed it becomes invalid. You will be required to present your wristband to security upon request. Lost wristbands will not be replaced.

As the Optus Gympie Music Muster is a 4 day event, you are welcome to come in and out of the festival as often as you need. Your wristband acts as your pass out.

AGE

The Optus Gympie Music Muster is an all ages event. Ticketed patrons under 18 must be accompanied by a Responsible Adult at all times. Children under the age of 5 are admitted free of charge with a ticket holding adult. Patrons under the age of 18 will not be able to purchase or consume alcohol.

BARS & ALCOHOL

The entertainment precinct is a licensed area. Consequently, no BVO alcohol can be brought into the entertainment precinct. There are 8 bars and 1 VIP bar at the Optus Gympie Music Muster, serving a variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks. A bar ticket system will be operating. You will need to purchase drink tickets and exchange them for drinks at the bar. Water is available from the bar as well as at water refill sites around the festival. Midstrength alcohol will be in force from midnight. Alcohol is permitted in campsite as long as it is not glass. We observe Responsible Serving of Alcohol, drink responsibly.

REMEMBER DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE.

FOOD AND MARKET STALLS

There will be a variety of stalls operating throughout the Muster. You will see numerous community groups in addition to a variety of commercial operators providing food throughout the day and evening. Also be sure to check out the market stalls operating on site. ATM's are available near the information hut at the festival main gate. The general store will be open daily stocking all of your essential needs.

WHAT TO BRING

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

- ✓ Professional Cameras and video recorders (small cameras are permitted)
- ✓ All animals including dogs & pets
- ✓ Glass – all glass is prohibited
- ✓ Umbrellas (raincoats should be used as an alternative)

SMOKING AREAS

Smoking is only permissible in the designated areas. These areas are clearly marked on site maps throughout the entertainment precinct. Due to smoking laws in QLD we ask you to refrain from smoking within the tents. Please dispose of your cigarette thoroughly in the facilities provided around the festival.

CAMPING AND CAMPFIRES

One of the greatest muster memories you will have relates to your camping experience. To make this a great experience make sure you say hello to your neighbours to build a community feeling and provide greater security. Be sure to keep noise to a minimum after 11pm and do not run generators past this time.

Ensure your tent is placed at least 2m away from your neighbor and 4m away from any campfires. Camping is only allowed on slashed areas and not beyond the perimeter marked.

Fire bans will be in place from 9am to 5pm. A total fire ban may be put into place in the event of dry weather and high winds. Campfires must be contained within a fire ring or protective barrier.

DISABLED CAMPING AREA

This area will have disabled toilets and showers. 240V power available if required for medical purposes from 6pm 18 August, 2012 until 8am 27 August, 2012 and must be requested prior to 18 August. Normal ID of proof of disablement will be required to utilise this area and must be organised through the Muster Office 07 5482 2099 prior to August 1.

INFO & SAFETY

Ambulance, Fire and Police Services will be operating throughout the festival, in conjunction with our security staff. Please see the map for details of their location and memorise in case of an emergency. The festival hotline number is 07 5482 2099.
